



Mission Moment



Despite all the risks, there are doctors, nurses and staff still working to help people with vision issues. Last year, the program served 350,000 patients – 10,000 more women than men, over 15,000 surgeries, over 52,000 pairs of glasses and over 50,000 children were helped. 
To the **Frankfort Panthers** Boys basketball team on their District and Regional titles.

There were 13 Council members at the March 12, 2015 Council meeting.

Andy Mollema - Rosemary Abbett has been hired as our new organist.

<u>Property:</u>

Andrea Frost – 1) the Property Committee made the motion to approve the replacement of the present light bulbs in the Sanctuary with energy saving LED bulbs at a cost of \$625.00 (36 total bulbs) and take to Council for its approval; and 2) the Committee also made the motion to approve the purchase of Ultra Insulating Triple Cell shades for the front and side entrance doors at a cost of \$600.00 and take to Council for its approval. Approved. It was also noted that a thank you goes out to Bill Frostic for all his repair and installation work done at the Church and at the Parsonage.
